Get under the hood with hands-on activities and a special guest

RENO, Nev. (March 26, 2026) – Motor on down to The Discovery for a high-octane day of hands-on automotive-themed activities for car enthusiasts of all ages on Saturday, March 28, from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. Visitors can explore the science and engineering behind automobiles through interactive exhibits and expert-led demonstrations.

Car Care Day at The Discovery is a unique opportunity for families, students and car lovers to explore the mechanics of motion, the physics of racing, and the innovations shaping the future of the automotive industry.

In partnership with NAPA AutoCare Centers, The Discovery will offer a variety of engaging activities designed to spark curiosity about the inner workings of cars and the systems that make them go, turn, and stop. Guests can get up close with real car components at the Auto Parts Petting Zoo, design and test a model race car at the Build and Test a Race Car station, experiment with impact forces and vehicle safety at the DIY Crash Testing Zone, check out classic and custom cars at the Wicked Wayz car show and more.

At this year's Car Care Day, visitors can meet NHRA Funny Car driver Ronn Capps and NHRA driver Maddi Gordon from 12 p.m. to 4 p.m. Capps is the second-winningest Funny Car pilot in NHRA history with 72 wins in the category. His 73 overall wins (1 Top Fuel) rank sixth amongst NHRA's four premier classes. Gordon is a former NHRA Jr. Dragster and Super Comp/Pro competitor, and was selected by Capps to drive his team's first Top Fuel car entry.

Admission is free for all visitors. Car Care Day is presented by the local NAPA Elite Member Auto Care Center and Women in Auto Care.
